Does the tree have a significant footing (10' or greater) in which it is retaining loose soil and rock; erosion prevention (If No, continue)

Has the tree been diagnosed with any infestation, disease, or other weakness undermining the long-term health of the tree(s) (If yes, continue) (Provide details)

Does the removal cause any hazard risk of damage to neighboring property or structure (If no continue)

What agency is performing the work? Is the agency licensed and possess a Certificate of Insurance (COI)?

Please note:

- Failure to disclose completely shall result in an unapproved Application and will be returned.
- Trees cut without application approval may be subject to remediation and/or penalty.
- Judicious pruning of trees (not wholesale tree topping) is strongly encouraged and should be undertaken with the advice of an arborist or other tree specialist.
